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For the contemporary settler-colonizing Nations, meaning the U2RIT, the assassination of the indigenous political-dissidents, of the victimized by them Nations, remains an absolutely non-negotiable matter.

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The method, for materializing these assassinations, of the “Operation Condor” is still being exploited; though having been modernized.

In Italy, the Carabinieri were employed, indefinitely from October 2006, in order to keep the, actually anti-colonialism-activist and whistle-blower, Roberto Saviano in one piece.

However, existing National-debts, already imposed settler-colonialism, existing diminished-sovereignty, existing international treaties, and other reasons allow the colonizers, through deception, to impose complicity to Nations the languages of which, they remain, due to their shallow glossary/grammar/syntax, vulnerable to deception.

For example, there are two, independent, notions: there is homelessness; and there are political-dissidents.

These two notions, by definition, they refer to overlapping sets of units. This means that, the intersection of two sets is non-empty set but neither is a subset of the other.

For legitimizing the assassination of political-dissidents within such deception-vulnerable Nations, the colonizers only have to methodize specific legislation which, criminally, treat these two notions faultily as if they were not referring to overlapping sets.

By having done this, they only need to, through gang-stalking, degrade the targeted by them political-dissident to homeless persons, thus excluding them from the protection which, the existing refuges/anti-human-trafficking/anti-transnational-organized-crimes laws might had rescued them.

Through the above mentioned false categorization, public facilities for “ALL HOMELESS” persons have been, wrongfully, established while, instead, public facilities for “ALL NON-POLITICAL-DISSIDENTS HOMELESS” should have been established.

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In Europe, drug-addicts, from those which frequently become convicted for various crimes, one could easily find someone eager to execute a death contract for just 70 euros.

Within this context and in the hypothetical case that, the Carabinieri hadn't offered protection to the Italian political-dissident:

- could anyone imagine a made-homeless Roberto Saviano having had chosen to sleep, among drug-addicts and convicts, in an ordinary facility for "ALL HOMELESS"?

- could anyone imagine a made-homeless Roberto Saviano having had not smelling badly, due to lacking of proper hygienic practices?

- could anyone imagine a made-homeless Roberto Saviano having had not totally avoiding social interaction, while walking at night, in deserted, due to Covid-19 preventive measures, streets, with unknown to him person which, either, on their feet, or, on their bicycles, they had had been chasing him?

- could anyone imagine a made-homeless Roberto Saviano not having had thrown, with discretion, to a garbage-can any food that might have been offered to him by unknown to him strangers, in order to avoid become poisoned (as Anna Stepanowna Politkowskaja and innumerable others political-dissidents)?

- could anyone imagine a made-homeless Roberto Saviano having had not chosen any kind of closed space, e.g. a public-telephone cabin, for sleeping during the nights in order to protect himself from becoming physically assaulted, at nights?

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All of the above reactions they are, simultaneously, considered:

- as normal for the “POLITICAL-DISSIDENTS and HOMELESS” (meaning, the intersection), but
- as abnormal for the “All THE HOMELESS” (meaning, the false categorization).

Consequently and since the legislation (and the non-scientific alleged “diagnostic-protocols” of the so-called “psychiatry”), does prevail against the rationality and the common-sense, the Roberto Saviano, without having been protected by his fellow Carabinieri, unavoidably, he would had been assassinated after having been, unjustly, thrown to colonialism’s front-organizations which in some countries, they are, traditionally, specialized in committing plausibly deniable assassinations of innocent civilians.

Homelessness

Homelessness is defined as living in housing that is below the minimum standard or lacks secure tenure. People can be categorized as homeless if they are: living on the streets (primary homelessness); moving between temporary shelters, including houses of friends, family and emergency accommodation (secondary homelessness); living in private boarding houses without a private bathroom or security of tenure (tertiary homelessness). The legal definition of homeless varies from country to country, or among different jurisdictions in the same country or region. United States government homeless enumeration studies also include people who sleep in a public or private place not designed for use as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings. People who are homeless are most often unable to acquire and maintain regular, safe, secure and adequate housing due to an unsteady or lack of income. Homelessness and poverty are interrelated. There is no methodological consent on counting the homeless and identifying their special needs; thus in most cities only estimated homeless populations are known.

Political repression

Political repression is the act of a state entity controlling a citizenry by force for political reasons, particularly for the purpose of restricting or preventing the citizenry's ability to take part in the political life of a society, thereby reducing their standing among their fellow citizens.

It is often manifested through policies such as human rights violations, surveillance abuse, police brutality, imprisonment, involuntary settlement, stripping of citizen's rights, lustration and violent action or terror such as the murder, summary executions, torture, forced disappearance and other extrajudicial punishment of political activists, dissidents, or general population. Political repression can also be reinforced by means outside of written policy, such as by public and private media ownership and by self-censorship within the public.

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Where political repression is sanctioned and organised by the state, it may constitute state terrorism, genocide, politicide or crimes against humanity. Systemic and violent political repression is a typical feature of dictatorships, totalitarian states and similar regimes. Acts of political repression may be carried out by secret police forces, army, paramilitary groups or death squads. Repressive activities have also been found within democratic contexts as well. This can even include setting up situations where the death of the target of repression is the end result.

If political repression is not carried out with the approval of the state, a section of government may still be responsible. An example are the FBI COINTELPRO operations in the United States between 1956 and 1971.

In some states, "repression" can be an official term used in legislation or the names of government institutions. For example, the Soviet Union had a legal policy of repression of political opposition defined in the penal code and Cuba under Fulgencio Batista had a secret police agency officially named the "Bureau for the Repression of Communist Activities".

Operation Condor

Operation Condor (Spanish: Operación Cóndor, also known as Plan Cóndor; Portuguese: Operação Condor) was a United States-backed campaign of political repression and state terror involving intelligence operations and assassination of opponents, officially and formally implemented in November 1975 by the right-wing dictatorships of the Southern Cone of South America.

Due to its clandestine nature, the precise number of deaths directly attributable to Operation

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Condor is highly disputed. Some estimates are that at least 60,000 deaths can be attributed to Condor, roughly 30,000 of these in Argentina, and the so-called "Archives of Terror" list 50,000 killed, 30,000 disappeared and 400,000 imprisoned. American political scientist J. Patrice McSherry gives a figure of at least 402 killed in operations which crossed national borders in a 2002 source, and mentions in a 2009 source that of those who "had gone into exile" and were "kidnapped, tortured and killed in allied countries or illegally transferred to their home countries to be executed... hundreds, or thousands, of such persons—the number still has not been finally determined—were abducted, tortured, and murdered in Condor operations." Victims included dissidents and leftists, union and peasant leaders, priests and nuns, students and teachers, intellectuals and suspected guerrillas. Although it was described by the Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) as "a cooperative effort by the intelligence/security services of several South American countries to combat terrorism and subversion," guerrillas were used as an excuse, as they were never substantial enough to control territory, gain material support by any foreign power, or otherwise threaten national security. Condor's key members were the governments in Argentina, Chile, Uruguay, Paraguay, Bolivia, and Brazil. Ecuador and Peru later joined the operation in more peripheral roles.

The United States government provided planning, coordinating, training on torture, technical support and supplied military aid to the Juntas during the Johnson, Nixon, Ford, Carter, and the Reagan administrations. Such support was frequently routed through the CIA.

Entrapment

Entrapment is a practice whereby a law enforcement agent or agent of the state induces a person to commit a "crime" that the person would have otherwise been unlikely or unwilling to commit. It "is the conception and planning of an offense by an officer or agent, and the procurement of its commission by one who would not have perpetrated it except for the trickery, persuasion or fraud of the officer or state agent."

Police conduct rising to the level of entrapment is broadly discouraged and thus, in many

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jurisdictions, is available as a defense against criminal liability. Sting operations, through which police officers or agents engage in deception to try to catch persons who are committing crimes, raise concerns about possible entrapment.

Depending on the law in the jurisdiction, the prosecution may be required to prove beyond a reasonable doubt that the defendant was not entrapped or the defendant may be required to prove that they were entrapped as an affirmative defense.

Roberto Saviano

Roberto Saviano (born September 22, 1979 in Naples) is an Italian writer and journalist . In his literary work and in his reports, he deals with the phenomenon of organized economic crime . Saviano is a member of the Osservatorio sulla Camorra e l'Illegalità ; he works for the magazine L'Espresso and the daily newspapers Il Manifesto and Corriere della Sera.

Episodes of Gomorrah

Following the publication of Gomorrah and his work against organized white-collar crime , Saviano received death threats. A few months after the book was published, he publicly mentioned names of Camorra leaders who had gone into hiding. At an anti-Mafia event in Casal di Principe, he shouted into the audience: " Michele Zagaria , Antonio Iovine , Francesco Schiavone - your power is based only on fear!" After that, the threats against him intensified. At the beginning of October 2006, the writer Umberto Eco appealed in the main news of Italian television for his protection and caused quite a stir in Italy. Saviano received personal protection from the Ministry of the Interior on October 13, 2006 and has since lived in hiding in changing places that he has to leave about every two days. He only maintains contact with his family.

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In October 2008 a key witness informed the Italian police that the Casalesi Camorra clan was planning to use a remote detonator to blow up Saviano in his car on the motorway between Rome and Naples by Christmas 2008. Saviano now doubts whether he would write his novel again: "Every morning I ask myself why I did that and I can't find an answer, I don't know whether it was worth it." Also in October 2008, in an interview, he suggested that the Camorra would now wait until its popularity waned before launching an attack. A normal life in public is no longer possible for him. Airlines refuse to carry him, and hotels and restaurants have their rooms searched for bombs before he visits. Saviano's expressions of frustration evoked many different expressions of solidarity among the Italian public. In the daily La Repubblica he announced that he would evade the current threat of leaving abroad.

Targeted Individual's Guide to Homelessness

What you should know about homelessness and shelters

You are either a targeted individual who has been driven into being homelessness/house-less or you are someone who is homeless who has discovered the reality of your situation.

In the 'homeless' circuit life is alot different than what you are used to-its a sub culture, one that the mainstream doesn't know much about it seems. I have found that there is corruption in this system like you would not believe.

The public and the state gives and there is still a homeless problem because the people who run the system are scam artists partially and a lot of the 'homeless' simply cannot or will not be housed. This is a vulnerable/marginalized population with basically no voice and splintered demographics making up the population as a whole. The homeless shelter circuit and services are con mans dreams come true..especially white collar criminals who work in administrative positions.

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I have seen everything from outright stealing to favoritism to misrepresentation of the organization to get funds, both government run and faith based.

It's an absolute mess. The people running these places or staying in them can often be criminals..career ones. This means that they will just target you as part of running thier business. CORRUPTION ALWAYS NEEDS TO AVOID EXPOSURE. WILLFUL INCOMPETENCE IS USUALLY A COVER FOR CORRUPTION AND THIS KIND OF WASTE MAKES PROFIT.

The shelter residents who do the targeting (your fellow 'homeless') are either going to get favored by the shelter or outsiders..either their drug dealer or the crooked in the criminal justice system-who have no shortage of people in on organized stalking and harassment at all levels.

Your circumstances are going to be alot different than other 'homeless' people. You also will have to make excuses as to why you don't want sec 8 or housing.DON'T SAY YOU ARE TARGETED. Getting you locked up is gangstalking's number 1 priority. You are going to get abused, set up, harassed and all kinds of mind games.

You are going to have to use all your knowledge of a lifetime to get through being targeted much less dealing with being homeless as well.

The psychological warfare campaign WILL NOW USE THIS STATUS LEVEL TO Demean YOU FURTHER.

So you are being kicked out of society, in a way. This is where you have to keep yourself alive via the internet, activism, public appearance like panhandling or other activity.

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Don't let homelessness swallow you up. Don't let the perps convince you that you don't exist or force you to forget all that has happened ..or drive you to lose your mind.

You will most likely be offered housing repeatedly in an obvious manner as a bribe to sell out to some untruth like a label or silence you about the harassment or to cease your whistle blowing activities. It's up to you what your level of durability is. I say don't sell out end of story.

If you are a smart TI you already know about other parts of gang stalking..keep this in mind as you go to different locations/buildings.This is the sort of environment where you will be treated very badly and people think they can get away with it.Document everything, point out always how the rules were not followed and how you were 'played' and especially any favor given to perps that are fellow homeless. You will find, believe it or not, that certain shelters actually host what seem like perp groups... don't even try to conceive of how inhumane and sinister this is, just document it. Hostels may have even worse activities waiting for you from a perp group.(This is where a shelter being accountable as a service agency has its advantages over hostels.)Another reason that you are forced into homeless shelters is that these are all basically mind control environments..every shelter I have been to employs some kind of tactic according to the definition of 'brain washing'. It's to keep the population in line.You will have to fight the urge to give up or fall into complacency. Harassment outside of the shelter adds to trauma.In some shelters you will find relief from outside harassment for a time.

You might want to opt out of being homeless in shelters (homebum) and become a traveling house-less person (hobo) which is more nomadic and gets the local system out of your life. However that lifestyle is hard, takes versatility and high intelligence. If yer a TI then yer targeted for those qualities anyway.
